

BOARD CRITERIA

- Experience and knowledge about the topic of the board you are interested in
- Experience of your local community and social housing
- Experience of working collaboratively and participating actively in discussions and deliberations
- Ambition to work alongside us to improve services in housing.
- Ability to read documents and communicate effectively
- Digital skills – able to use technology to facilitate taking part
- Listening skills to deal appropriately with fellow board members and wider stakeholders
- Commitment to abide by the code of conduct and treat everyone with respect and abide by the confidentiality of the discussions and materials shared as directed within each meeting

This experience can be from your work, the role you play as an active tenant or homeowner, as a volunteer, or member of a community. When you answer the questions on the application, please let us know about the ways you think you meet the criteria above.

Additional conditions

- Must declare any conflict of interests
- Members of Tenant forum and Homeowner forum will not be eligible to be selected through this process but both bodies will have two different members on each board
- Members must either be
 - a tenant
 - A homeowner or leaseholder
 - Someone who would have the right to succeed to a tenancy
 - Non tenant or leaseholder household members who are living in the premises for more than 12 months

Additionally for Building Safety Residents' Board

- Must live in a high rise building i.e. over 7 storeys or 18m
